

# Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

Between



JAYPEE INSTITUTE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, NOIDA  
(JIIT)

And

UNITED & UNITED

(U&U)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into this 01<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2023 by and between Jaypee Institute of Information Technology, A-10, Sector-62, Noida-201309, Uttar Pradesh, India. Hereinafter called as JIIT and/or the first party

And

UNITED & UNITED having its office in 52, Sukhdev Vihar, New Delhi – 110025 hereinafter referred as U&U and/ or the Second Party

WHEREAS, JIIT, the first party, is a higher educational institute that was established in the year 2001 and was declared as a "Deemed to be University" under Section 3 of UGC Act 1956 in the year 2004.

WHEREAS, UNITED & UNITED is a law firm dedicated towards protection and enforcement of Intellectual Property Rights, of which Mr. Shravan Kumar Bansal (Advocate and Registered Patent Agent) and Mr. Sheel Kumar Bansal (Advocate) are the Partners.

WHEREAS, JIIT and U&U have mutually agreed to execute this Memorandum of Understanding towards *inter alia* facilitating the incorporation of the IPR Cell in JIIT, imparting training on IPR laws to the faculty, administration, members, and students of JIIT and towards the filings, prosecution, registrations, renewals, oppositions, revocations, cancellations, infringements, claims, appeals of IPR matters of JIIT and performance of any matters ancillary with or incidental thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration herein mentioned the parties accept the terms and conditions as mutually agreed and convey their acceptance.

#### I. DEFINITIONS OF TERMS

1. In this Empanelment (as hereinafter defined) the following words and expressions shall have meanings hereby assigned to them, except where the context requires otherwise:
2. The "JIIT" shall mean Jaypee Institute of Information Technology with its premises located in Noida, India.
3. The "U&U" shall mean UNITED & UNITED, the second party, whose Bid has been accepted by the JIIT and includes the Firm/Agency's legal representatives, his/her successors and permitted assignees.
4. The "WORK" shall mean and include all works to be executed, all items and things to be provided/ done and services and activities to be performed by the U&U in accordance with the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding.

#### II. SCOPE OF WORK

The Scope of work shall encompass the following activities:

1. The U&U will perform the work of drafting, filing, prosecuting, representing, and appearing on behalf of the JIIT before various judicial, quasi-judicial, and administrative

bodies in relation to matters involving Trademarks, Patents, Design, Copyrights, Geographical Indications, and other Intellectual Property Rights.

2. The projects shall be handled by the U&U upon receipt of the relevant information and instructions in writing by the JIIT.

3. U&U shall provide a prior art search report to the inventors before initiating the drafting of the specification of the patent application.

4. U&U shall on a regular basis keep the JIIT informed of all the legal incidences, time frames, processes, and developments involved in the matters assigned by JIIT to U&U.

### III. FEES

1. The U&U shall be entitled to issue an invoice against the JIIT in accordance with the fee schedule which has been accepted by the JIIT. A copy of the fee schedule containing the comprehensive fee structure of the U&U towards its various Intellectual Property Rights related services is annexed herewith as Annexure – A.

2. The payment shall be remitted by the JIIT within a period of 30 (Thirty) days from the date of receipt of the invoice by the JIIT.

3. The service of invoice shall be made by the U&U electronically through email, in addition to serving hard copy by courier/post to the JIIT. Provided that the service of invoice shall be deemed to be completed upon receipt of the invoice by the JIIT through either electronic or physical delivery, or both.

### IV. DURATION OF THE MOU:

The MOU shall be valid for a period of 05 (Five) Years from the date of its execution (10.09.2019), which is extendable for a period of a further period of 05 (Five) Years. However, the total period of the MOU shall not exceed 10 (Ten) years on the same terms and conditions, including costs, from the date of commencement of work, subject to quarterly appraisal and review by the designated authority of the JIIT.




## V. TERMINATION:

The JIIT shall be entitled to terminate the MOU before the scheduled time by giving advance notice of three (03) months only in case it does not find the performance of the U&U to be satisfactory as per the parameters set out in the MOU of the contract or not in conformity with the terms and conditions of the MOU. In the event of premature closure of the contract, for reasons mentioned hereinabove, the security deposit shall be absolutely forfeited by the JIIT.

## VI. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with this MOU shall be determined by the appointment of a single arbitrator to be agreed between the parties, or failing MOU within fourteen days, after either party has given to the other a written request to concur in the appointment of an arbitrator, by an arbitrator to be appointed by the JIIT. The decision of the arbitrator decision shall be final and binding upon the parties. The place of Arbitration shall be New Delhi. The Indian laws shall be applicable to the arbitration.



