Agreed Principles

1 Principles of Academic Cooperation

The parties agree to work together in good faith to carry out any of those areas of academic cooperation listed in Item 5 of the Schedule (referred to in this Memorandum as "Area of Cooperation").

2 Term and termination

- (a) This Memorandum commences on the date specified in Item 2 of Schedule 1 and ends five (5) years from that date.
- (b) Either party may terminate this Memorandum at any time and for any reason with immediate effect by giving written notice to the other party.

3 Non binding Memorandum with exceptions

- (a) This Memorandum constitutes a statement of the mutual intentions of the parties in relation to any Area of Cooperation.
- (b) Except for clauses 8 (Confidentiality), 9 (Privacy) and 10 (Public Announcements), this Memorandum does not give rise to any legally binding obligations on the parties.

4 Formalising agreements

The parties intend that any agreement in relation to any Area of Cooperation will be documented in a formal written agreement executed by the parties in accordance with their respective policies and procedures.

5 Memorandum will not prevent cooperation with other parties

This Memorandum will not prevent any party from undertaking any activities with third parties or acting independently of the other.

6 Facilitation of cooperation

Charles Sturt and Jaypee IIT will each appoint a Coordinating Officer, as set out in the Schedule, who will negotiate and manage the development of any Area of Cooperation.

7 Costs

Each party must pay its own costs and expenses in relation to anything arising from this Memorandum.

8 Confidentiality

- (a) The parties must ensure that they keep all discussions and all information received by the other party in relation to any Area of Cooperation confidential, and not give access to or disclose the content of the discussions and all information to any third party.
- (b) The obligation of confidentiality in this clause does not extend to confidential information that is required to be disclosed by operation of law but only to the extent that such disclosure is necessary by law.
